CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

In the framework of the implementation of the project entitled "Green-health-safety Nexus for new Urban Spaces -GreeNexUs" with the SARF code 08.0208 and the reference number of the project Grant Agreement No: 101073437 and scientific coordinator Thomas Bartzanas in the Operational Programme " REA.A – Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions & Support to Experts A.1 – MSCA Doctoral Networks", funded by European Commission (EUROPEAN RESEARCH EXECUTIVE AGENCY – REA), the Financial Administrative Support Unit (FASU) of the Special Account for Research Funding (SARF) of the Agricultural University of Athens (AUA) intends to sign a work contract and invites natural persons to express their interest in undertaking the relevant projects, in accordance with the conditions set out below.

POSITIONS

In the framework of this Call a work position is announced for the project entitled "Green-health-safety Nexus for new Urban Spaces -GreeNexUs" with the SARF code 08.0208 and the reference number of the project Grant Agreement No: 101073437 and scientific coordinator Thomas Bartzanas in the Operational Programme " REA.A – Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions & Support to Experts A.1 – MSCA Doctoral Networks", funded by European Commission (EUROPEAN RESEARCH EXECUTIVE AGENCY – REA), by means of a contract of employment, which will specify the way of employment in the Project.

A detailed description of the position is set out in the table included in the Annex.

SUBJECT

The scope of the work of the temporary staff to be contracted to SARF AUA under this call is set out in the table included in the Annex.



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A more detailed description of the scope of the contract, as well as the deliverables related to it, will be reflected in the contracts to be concluded between the FASU (SARF AUA) and the selected candidate.

The correct execution and control of the project deliverables will be certified by the Scientific COORDINATOR of the project.

PAY

The total fee amount is #139,298.40 #€ (One Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Eight point Forty Euros). This amount will be subject to all legal deductions. The amount of #139,298.40#€ consists of #99,878.40#€ that refers to the Living Allowance, the amount of #21,600.00#€ that refers to the Mobility Allowance and the amount of #17,820.00#€ that refers to the Family Allowance. The amount of #17,820.00#€ corresponds to the 75% of the full amount of #23,760.00#€ of the Family Allowance (660€/month as described in Horizon Europe Work Programme (MSCA Work Programme part)). The remaining 25% of the family allowance shall be given to the candidate after the second phase of the project and after amendment of the GA through which the extra amount shall be provided to the project partners where necessary.

TIME FRAME

The total estimated duration of the contracts to be concluded between the SARF AUA and the selected staff will be up to thirty-six (36) months.

Contracts may be renewed or extended by decisions of the Research Committee, on the recommendation of the Scientific COORDINATOR, without limitation, until the end date of the project/programme, provided that they are within the approved budget limits of each project or programme. Contracts concluded for the needs of a project/programme that does not have a clear end date may be renewed or extended for a period not exceeding a total of five (5) years, provided that they are within the approved budget limits of the project or programme.

PLACE OF EXECUTION

As a place of execution of the program, the contractor is allowed to work at the premises and facilities of the Laboratory of Farm Structures of the Agricultural University of Athens, located at 75 Iera Odos, 11855, Athens.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AT THE DATE OF RECRUITMENT

1. Master's degree in environmental science or similar discipline, with a specialization in LCA (preferable civil, architecture, environmental or chemical engineer)
2. Knowledge of MS Office, particularly Outlook, PowerPoint, Excel and Word.



3. Fluent in English (written and oral)
4. No more than 4 years of previous research activity
5. The Doctoral Candidate must not have resided in Greece for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the recruitment date and not have carried out in Greece his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.).

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

The following information must be included in the application file of each applicant:

- The application with reference to the call
- A detailed curriculum vitae with reference to the call
- Clear photocopies of academic qualifications
- Copies of the documents supporting the qualifications listed in the CV.
- A declaration of responsibility in accordance with Law no. 1599/1986, in which the interested parties shall state that:
 - A) they have an excellent knowledge of the English language
 - B) the relevant professional register/technical chamber, if they are registered,
 - C) they have not been convicted by a final judgment for participation in a criminal organisation, bribery, fraud or money laundering,



(D) they are not bankrupt or being wound up, in compulsory administration or the subject of proceedings concerning bankruptcy, having their affairs administered by the courts, have not entered into an arrangement with creditors or have not suspended business activities,

(E) they have not been convicted of any offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgment which has the force of res judicata and have fulfilled any obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes and duties,

(F) they have read and understood the terms of the call for expressions of interest and accept them unconditionally,

(G) they have not made any false or inaccurate statements when providing the information requested by the Contracting Authority,

(H) there is no impediment to their undertaking the work and receiving the fee and that, if their application is accepted, they will ensure that any impediment to this end is removed,

(I) they waive their right to seek compensation in case the Contracting Authority finally decides not to conclude the contract.

EVALUATION PROCEDURE

The applications for each position are evaluated by the following Evaluation Committee as appointed by the Research Committee of SARF AUA.



If a practical test or a test of specific knowledge is carried out, the candidates participation will be assessed as pass or fail. Unsuccessful candidates will be placed on the disqualification list. The mark for each candidate's interview will be the average of the marks obtained by the members of the Evaluation Committee. The content of the interview, including the critical and substantive points, will be summarised in the minutes of the Evaluation Committee and the marks awarded to each candidate will be briefly explained by each member of the Evaluation Committee.

The Scientific COORDINATOR, who acts as the Chairperson of the Evaluation Committee, is appointed as a regular member of the Evaluation Committee. The Committee is appointed by a decision of the Research Committee of SARF AUA. The term of office of the Committee is equal to the duration of the project if the project has a clear end date, otherwise the term of office is annual. Members of the Committee may not be spouses or partners nor have blood or marriage relations up to the third degree of consanguinity with any candidate. If a member of the Commission is prevented from exercising its functions under the previous subparagraph, it shall notify the other members of the Commission in writing, requesting that its alternate member replace it.

The recommendation of the Committee is forwarded to the Research Committee of SARF AUA.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

After their approval by the Research Committee of SARF AUA, the preliminary results of the evaluation are posted on the website of the SARF AUA web department, www.elke.aua.gr. After the expiry of the deadline for lodging an objection according to par. 2 of article 245 of Law 4957/2022 (Government Gazette 141/A/21.08.2022), the results are automatically final.

LODGING OF OBJECTIONS

Candidates who have applied for a post under this Call are entitled to:

A. lodging an objection against their ranking within 5 calendar days from the day after the results are posted, by submitting a written request to the FASU SARF AUA.



B. access to the data of the individual application file and the evaluation sheets of the other candidates, following their written request to the FASU SARF AUA within 5 calendar days after the results are published.

C. no objection is allowed on grounds relating to the interview or knowledge test and the skills and work efficiency test.

Candidates who intend to exercise their legitimate right regarding the selection procedure and the results may, on written request, ask for access to the files and supporting documents of other candidates. The documents submitted by the candidates constitute personal data of the candidates under Article 4 of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679. At the same time, the same documents constitute administrative documents under Article 5 par. 1 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, if and insofar as they have been taken into account when forming the relevant judgment. The right of access may be satisfied under the terms of the legislation on personal data and Article 5 of the Code of Administrative Procedure and in accordance with the conditions consistently accepted by the Authority for the Protection of Personal Data Protection (PDPA 28/2018). Before the data are provided to applicants, it is possible to inform the persons to whom the data refer. In any case, applicants are informed through this Call that the documents and supporting documents they submit may be granted to their co-applicants without being informed individually before such grant. This information, here, takes the form of prior notification of this possibility.

Requests for objections must be submitted in one of the following ways: in person, by an authorised proxy, by post, by courier. The date of submission of the application is the date on which it is deposited at the Protocol Secretariat of SAFU SARF AUA. If the closing date of the above deadline is not a working day, the deadline will be postponed to the next working day. Late applications will not be considered and will not be examined.

The following Objections Committee is responsible for examining the objections, as appointed by the Research Committee of SARF AUA. The members of the Objections Committee are not allowed to be appointed as members of the Evaluation Committee, unless they are the Scientific Coordinators for their projects. In this case, they shall participate ex officio in the Evaluation Committee and for these projects they shall be replaced in the Objections Committee by their alternate member. Members of the Objections Committee may not be related to any candidate by blood or marriage up to the third degree. If a member of the Commission is prevented from exercising its functions, it shall notify the other members of the Commission and the institution which appointed it in writing, requesting that its alternate member replace it. After the decision of the Objections Committee, the evaluation results become final.

The results (provisional and final) are posted on the SARF AUA website and in the "DIAVGIA" (TRANSPARENCY INITIATIVE) programme.

The Objections Committee examines the objections submitted and makes a reasoned recommendation to the Research Committee to accept or reject them. By decision of the selection board, the final result lists are validated and the decision on each objection is communicated to the candidate. If the Research Committee finds an infringement of the law or of the Funding Guidelines or any other regulatory act, either on its own initiative or following an objection, it may decide to repeat the call in whole or in part. In the case of omissions or defects that need to be completed or corrected, the Research Committee may, instead of reopening the notice, complete or correct the omissions or defects, if this is possible.

OTHER TERMS

1. The following documents are taken into account as evidence of the subject matter and duration of the experience:
A certificate from the insurance institution confirming the duration of the insurance (for candidates whose experience is in the private sector) or a certificate from the relevant public body (for candidates whose experience is in the public sector).
If the certificate from the insurance institution does not indicate the specific experience required under this Call for applications, a contract or a service provision card covering the duration of the specific experience is required.
2. For those applicants whose higher education qualifications (undergraduate and postgraduate) are required or taken into account and have been awarded by foreign institutions, they must be accompanied by certificates of recognition from DOATAP (OR EQUIVALENT)
3. Certification of knowledge of foreign languages is demonstrated on the basis of Article 1 of Decree 146/2007 'Amendment of the provisions of Decree 50/2001 - Determination of qualifications for appointment to positions in public sector bodies as in force'



(Government Gazette 185/3.8.2007/A'), in conjunction with the last subparagraph of paragraph 1 of Article 1 of Decree 116/2006 'Amendment of Article 28 of Decree 50/2001' (Government Gazette 115/9.6.2006/A'). For proof of a foreign language, it is sufficient to submit a copy of the relevant language certificate.

4. The certification of computer literacy is proved on the basis of the provisions of Article 27 par. 6 of Decree 50/2001 "Determination of qualifications for appointment to positions in public sector bodies as in force" (Government Gazette A 39/5.3.2001, Government Gazette A 24/30.01.2013 and Government Gazette A 63/9.3.2005).
5. In the event of a tie between candidates, the candidate with the highest degree will be ranked first and, in the event of a tie, the candidate with the highest postgraduate degree will be ranked first.
6. Throughout the duration of the project and if the need arises to replace persons selected in accordance with this Call, the replacement will be made by selecting - based on grade/ranking - another candidate(s) from the existing ranking list.
7. Please note that this Call may be cancelled at any stage, without each candidate retaining any claim against FASU SARF AUA.
8. In case of non-compliance with the terms of the contract by the selected candidate, a written warning letter will be sent to the selected candidate, indicating the reasons for the deviation, giving him/her reasonable time to correct and comply.
